Your clients can also take in the detail of the 9-metre scale model of the Murchison oil production platform - as close as many will ever get to an offshore oil rig.

The rich and varied collections are displayed over four floors in the modern museum building and in the historic 16th century Provost Ross's House. The museum also offers fantastic views over Aberdeen Harbour.
